Agatha Christie's work has been adapted extensively resulting in transformations that are both textual and cultural. While many adaptations are best known for being quaint murder mysteries there are many adaptations of her work that draw on horror aesthetics. This book will look at how the growth of Agatha Christie adaptations have grown increasingly darker. Of key relevance to this study is the work of Sarah Phelps whose *Witness for the Prosecution* and *And Then There Were None* Ordeal by Innocence *The ABC Murders* and *The Pale Horse* all are darker than their precedents. Born out of their contemporary screen contexts they use entrenched literary and filmic codes of Gothic horror as central reference points for audiences. Drawing on adaptation scholarship where adapters are interpreters as well as creators this study will look at how Agatha Christie is closer to Gothic horror than what we realise.

Consequently the first major part of this paper is dedicated to a brief study of the genre of fantastic literature in general particularly the very problematic task of defining its distinctive characteristics

By looking at the fantastic tradition in America particularly that of New England including the prevalent features and themes marking the American variety of the fantastic and highlighting the contribution some eminent American authors have made to the genre the second part then focuses on the fantastic in American literature

Finally the third major section of this paper provides a detailed study of the life and work of one of the chief American writers of fantastic prose fiction H P Lovecraft

After an account of Lovecraft's life and personality including some of the countless misconceptions circulating since his death a critical evaluation of his literary achievement and influences and a short discussion of his impact on modern popular culture a large part of this section is dedicated to a thorough analysis of his unique concept of fantastic fiction while certain aspects of his work inevitably link him to his literary precursors there are others clearly setting him apart from any writer of the fantastic that came before him
