Another significant but equally overlooked subject is the focus of the final chapter which analyzes the travel writing of internationally best selling author Murakami Haruki. Murakami's great corpus of work includes a one volume study of the 2000 Sydney Olympics which Morton discusses in detail. *The Alien Within* breaks new ground in its treatment of the exotic in modern Japanese writing and in its discussion of authors and work hitherto absent from critical discussions in English.
